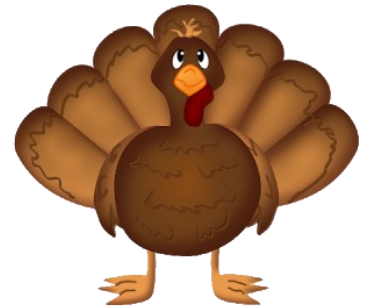

News from 1st/2nd Grade

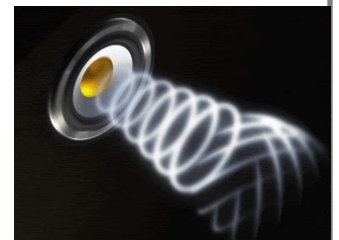

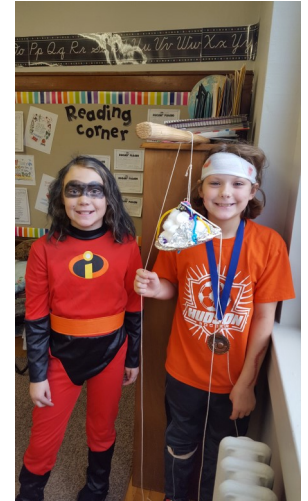
REMEMBER YOUR GYM SHOES EVERY MONDAY AND THURSDAY
